



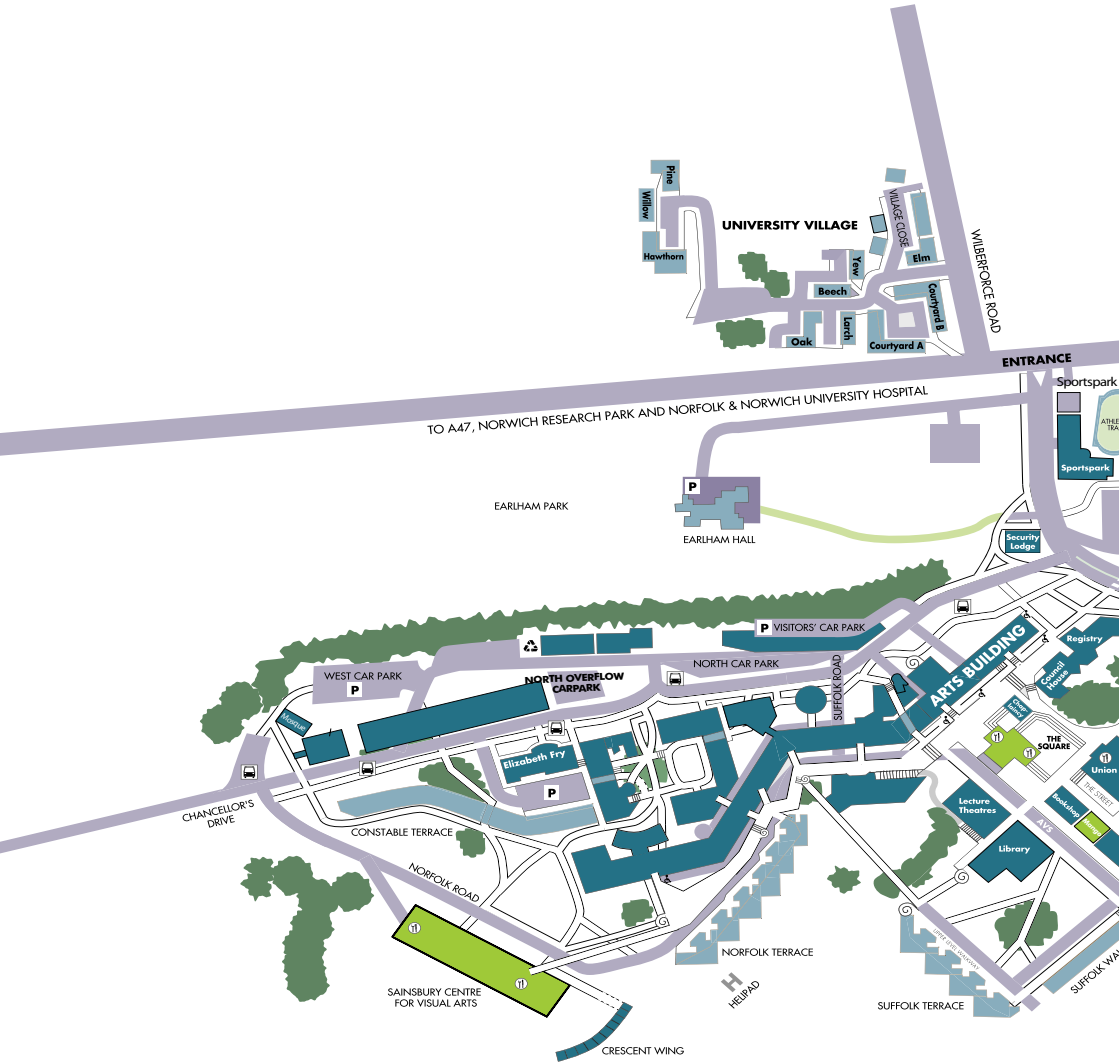

## Private Sector Accommodation

For students who prefer not to live in residences, or for those students not guaranteed a room in residences, there is a large stock of private rented accommodation available in Norwich. Details of many houses, flats, bedsits and lodgings, which are available for renting in the private sector, are held by the Student Union Advice Centre.

The Advice Centre can give you access to an online 'housing list', and offer general advice and information about the private sector, but you must deal directly with the agent or landlord when making accommodation arrangements.
